Note to school nurses: Permission Slips inform parents about the details of upcoming field trips. They often include information regarding the purpose of the event, date and time, cost, and its potential impact on school bus arrangements (i.e. the need for child to be picked up at school). Because permission slips also transfer liability to parents, schools have a duty to inform parents about potential risks posed by the activity. This allows parents to make an informed decision regarding their child's participation.

With regard to Lyme and other tick-borne illnesses, permission slips could be accompanied with basic information regarding tick bite prevention. This would give parents an opportunity to reduce their child's risk of a bite. A check box on the form could indicate that the parents received and read the material.

The sample permission slip below is meant to be informative but it is not intended as legal advice. Therefore, you should have the form approved by the appropriate school district personnel before implementing it.
